

Babe Ruth League, Inc. Scholarship Requirements

In 2001, Babe Ruth League, Inc. established a college scholarship program to provide financial assistance to former Cal Ripken Baseball, Babe Ruth Baseball and Babe Ruth Softball players looking to further their education beyond high school.

In order to be considered for a Babe Ruth League, Inc. scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- You must have participated in a Cal Ripken Baseball, Babe Ruth Baseball or Babe Ruth Softball League anytime during the ages of 4-18.
- You must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- You must be a high school senior or college student at the time of application.
- You must complete an application to be submitted to Babe Ruth League, Inc., along with a copy of your high school transcript, a letter of recommendation is optional, by July 3¹st of each year. Such application requires a 100-word essay detailing how playing in the Babe Ruth program has affected your life.

Scholarships will be awarded based on an applicant's high school academic achievement, participating activities, community involvement and on the contents of the essay.

The scholarship is a one-time award of \$1,000 and cannot be combined with any other Babe Ruth League sponsored scholarship.

Babe Ruth League employees and their immediate families are not eligible to qualify for any Babe Ruth League sponsored scholarship.

The scholarship award is sent in the Fall to the recipient upon verification (a copy of a tuition bill or first semester schedule).
