

NORMAN R. MESSIER MAY 11, 1939 TO DECEMBER 17, 2015

Norman R. Messier, 76, of Lyndon, Vermont, passed away on December 17, 2015.

Norm grew up and went to school in Franklin, Vermont, graduating from Franklin High School in 1957. He matriculated to what was Johnson's Teachers College and finished with a Master's in 1961. For six years he taught at Highgate High School, was guidance counselor at Fairfax for a year and then worked in school administration at the Orleans Essex North Supervisory Union. In 1985, Norm became the Superintendent for the Caledonia North Supervisory Union until retiring there in 1996.

Norm loved sports and coached soccer, boys and girls basketball, baseball and softball. He first became involved with Babe Ruth League in 1972 umpiring at regional tournaments. He went on to serve as Assistant State and State Commissioner for Vermont. In 2006, he was elected New England Regional Commissioner and an automatic member of the Babe Ruth League Board of Directors.

In addition over the years Norm was a trustee and held seats on various boards including: Lyndon Institute, the School Board for Lyndon and Riverside, Johnson College Alumni Association, and Lyndon State College.
